### Chico

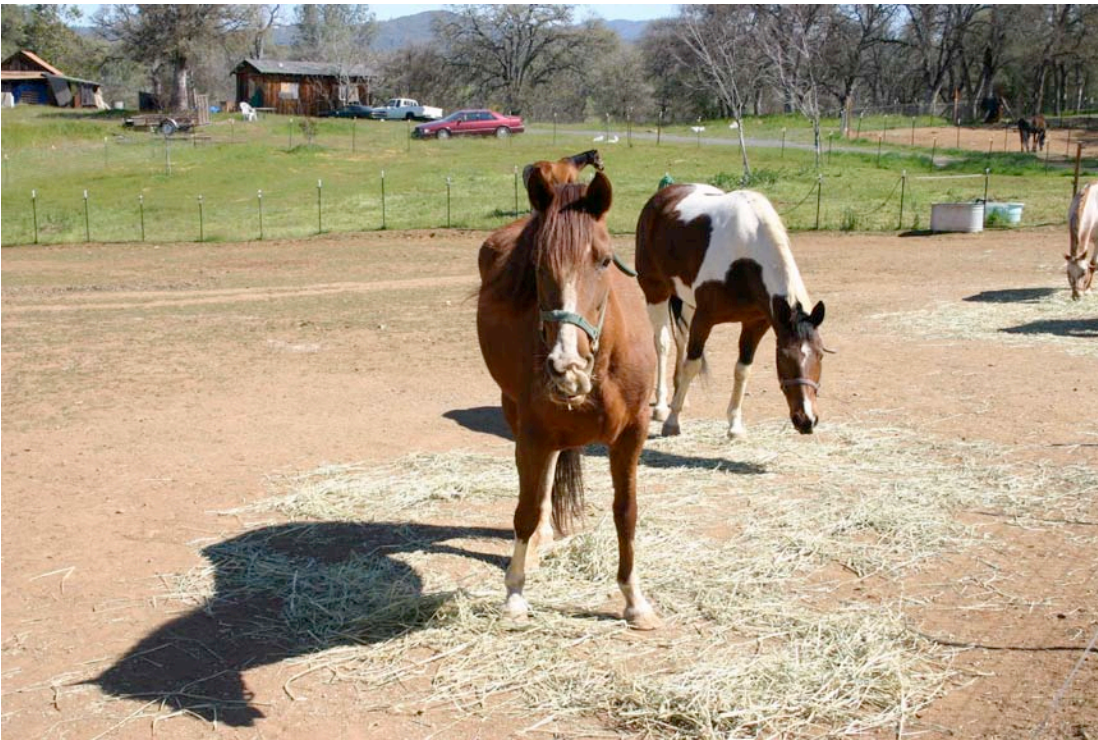
